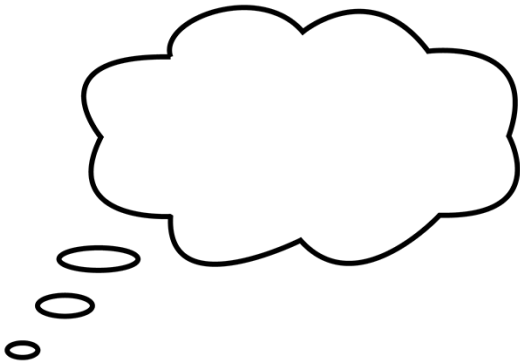
The leadership group meeting

The Plan



The big idea is to make sure the Board can make a difference to people with learning disabilities lives by working with people and organisations across Cornwall

We will ask people how they think that can happen

We will share the ideas we have and ask them for their ideas



The Plan

These are the Big Questions we will ask people to think about

1. What has been good about the Partnership Board so far?
2. How can the Board make a difference?
3. How can the Board be part of the Bigger Picture?



Think about when the Board has done a good job and made a difference...

Who helped it happen?

Give an example of what happened



What has been good about the Partnership Board so far?

How can the Partnership Board make a difference?



How can the Board show what all services (not only services just for people with a learning disability) should do for people with a learning disability to live a healthy good life?



How can the Board show or talk about what is most important to people?



How can the Board target its work to what is most important to people?

How can the Partnership Board be part of the bigger picture and connected to other work in Cornwall?

How is the Board connected to people who are often not heard?



How are different services and groups connected to the Board or supporting it?

How can the Board include and speak up for who do not use words?

How can the Partnership Board be part of the bigger picture?

How should the Partnership Board Work to do a good job?



Who should be a member of the Board?



Doing the work in and between meetings



Co Chairing by someone with a learning disability who helps lead the meetings and make decisions



How can other people hear what the Board is doing?

How the Board can ask people about this



1. Have a survey
2. Have a pack or list of the questions we are asking
3. Ask every team, group or support organisation to feedback or help people to feedback
4. Link to other plans like the Children and Young People's families network road show plans
5. Hold a meeting ourselves

We want to know from the Partnership Board



1. Do you think these are the right questions to ask people and share their ideas on?
2. Can you help share this or add to the list of people we send this to?
3. Could there be a road show?
4. How can you help the Partnership Board do this review so we build the best way of working?



Next steps – the review goes live



Sam from Learning Disability England will make any changes from the Partnership Board meeting



Then the review will go live and people can start sharing ideas



Next steps - after we get the feedback



The Leadership group will work with Learning Disability England to check all the ideas and work out what is important to do next.

This small group will write a draft plan for -

- How the Board meetings work and rules for the future
- How the Board is part of the bigger picture and is connected to other people or groups
- How the Board really makes a difference

The plan is that the Partnership Board starts working differently by September

The leadership group will share an update at the May meeting
